SUBJECT: DSA-SS/CC change without regulatory effect California Mechanical and Plumbing codes.

The California Division of the State Architect (DSA) is proposing to repeal the DSA-SS/CC banner in Title 24 Parts 4 and 5, except for Chapter 1 of these Parts. This banner is specifically reserved for alternative regulations related to structural safety for community colleges. DSA has not adopted any alternative regulations in Parts 4 and 5. This banner has been used in error by DSA when adopting these parts of the code. DSA seeks to rectify this by repealing these banners.

This proposed change meets the requirements of the Administrative Procedure Act, Building Standards Law, and the California Administrative Code, Section 1-421(c) for a "change without regulatory effect" as it does not impose any new requirement for the design or construction of buildings and associated structures and equipment.
